Our gifts to *Presbyterians Sharing* support Rev. David Pandy-Szekeres as he serves with the Reformed Church of the Sub-Carpathian Ukraine, a church of ethnic Hungarians in Ukraine. David supervises the work of RCCU missionaries and coordinates four Christian secondary schools. Ferenc Homoki, one of the missionaries that David supervises, is working with the Roma community in Nagyberég. Ferenc has established regular worship services and Bible studies, and has built a good relationship with the people. He and his wife Dianna have started an informal school for children who have not attended school before. Plans are underway to construct a multipurpose building to serve as a place of worship and as a kindergarten. Let us pray for David, Ferenc, the missionaries of the RCCU and our partner church in Ukraine.
