Winnipeg Inner City Missions: Learning through play

Our gifts to *Presbyterians Sharing* support Winnipeg Inner City Missions as it cares for and advocates for the needs of individuals and families in inner city Winnipeg, the majority of whom are Aboriginal. Winnipeg Inner City Mission's Learning and Play Program supports preschoolers and their caregivers. It helps build self-esteem and teaches literacy and learning through play; provides a safe space away from the streets where gang members and other dangers lurk; nurtures joy and excitement, and provides socialization for children and their caregivers. It also provides an opportunity for caregivers to seek advice on social concerns and/or parenting issues. Let us pray for Winnipeg Inner City Missions as it works to shine the love of Christ in inner city Winnipeg.

Participation in Communion

For some time now the PCC has stated that "baptized children, being within the covenant, are 'covenant members' of the church and may be admitted to the Lord's Table at the discretion of the Session and with their parent(s) consent. It is [still] their responsibility and privilege, when they reach an appropriate age, to profess their faith publically and be received by the Session as 'professing members'". (**Book of Forms** section 140.1)

The elders want to remind parents of their responsibility to talk with their children about the meaning of communion before allowing their children to partake. Our Sunday School also gives instruction.
