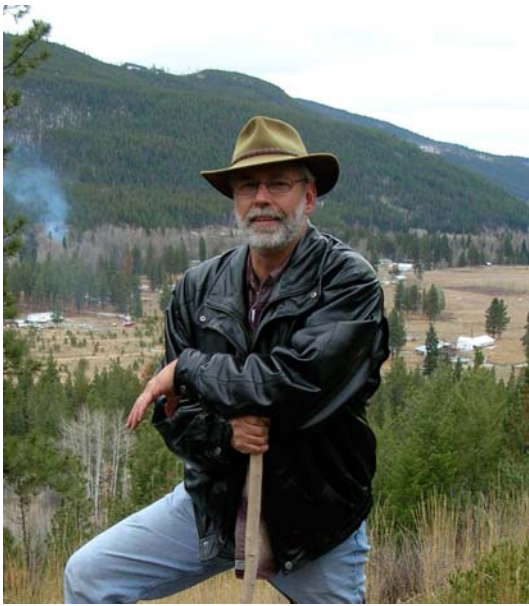
In an effort to increase the **security measures** of Calvin Church, the **west door will be locked** during each Worship Service.

**David Collins** has spent 30 years in some of the most depressed regions of the globe. Exposure to extreme circumstances has caused him to seek out sustainable solutions in the midst of human cruelty and natural disasters. He has discovered that sustainable change is only possible with a change of conviction and belief. He is also convinced that the values that honour God also honour society and bring health and well-being to any community.

David is the son of missionary parents. He and his wife spent their childhood living in the context of the Vietnam War. They later returned to work with the Vietnamese who fled Vietnam and were trapped in refugee camps in Thailand and the Philippines.

He is the founder of several organizations including, Canadian Food for the Hungry Int'l, the largest NGO headquartered in Western Canada, the Global Hunger Foundation & now Paradigm Ministries. He has been a pastor, CEO, consultant and mentor.

He has recently published his first book and continues to help people understand the power of ideas and the consequences of belief. He passionately seeks to help people understand their true motives and how they correspond to Biblical integrity. He offers workshops for the Christian community in Abbotsford and will encourage you to step out of your box.
