General Assembly 2010 - Sydney, Nova Scotia. Part 2: Worship

The assembly opened on June 6th with a Sunday evening worship and communion service attended by commissioners, local Presbyterians and ecumenical guests. An 80-voice choir from the Presbytery of Cape Breton was accompanied by the Cape Breton Orchestra. It was a very moving experience to worship in such a large gathering. Each morning from 8:30 to 9:15 a different group, mostly from Cape Breton, conducted worship. The theme of the Assembly was "Sailing into the Future", and the theme hymn was "Will your anchor hold in the storms of life?" Many of the hymns, Bible readings and meditations had a maritime flavour. Morning worship set the tone for the day.
