We recently received a visit from two outreach workers from **the Salvation Army Outreach Program - Homelessness Initiative**, who are responsible for helping the homeless and who have produced a pamphlet listing the **food resources** available in the community, especially among the Christian community (a copy is in the office). We have learned the following:

- Meals are available every weekday for **lunch** and 6 out of 7 **suppers**.
- Several churches supplement the **Food Bank**, including our own.
- We are advised **not to give out money** to anyone (it could be used for the wrong purposes and in only perpetuates panhandling).
