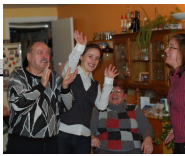

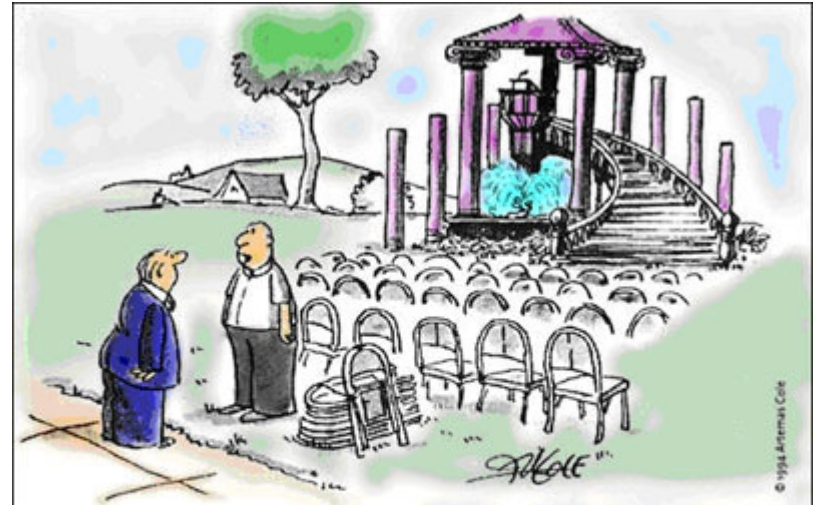


JOSHUA HOUSE MINISTRIES:
