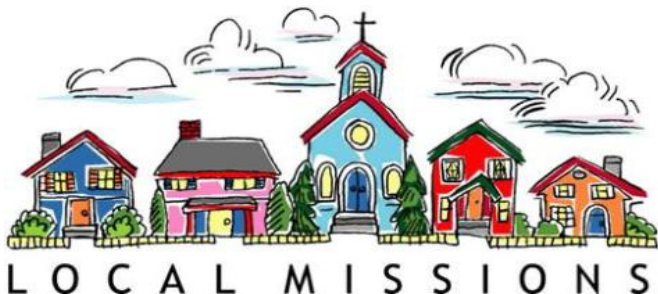

Our gifts to Presbyterians Sharing support Hummingbird Ministries in British Columbia's lower mainland. Hummingbird Ministries is walking with Aboriginal people and with the church and others towards developing a good relationship. Healing circles help restore hope, freedom and justice. The Wai Wah Aboriginal Sports and Recreation project provides healthy alternatives for Aboriginal youth. The Aboriginal Leadership in Ministry project provides a forum for discussions on ministry, theology and Aboriginal cultures. The Musical Kids project provides basic music and voice lessons, and the Kids Crafts project helps children have fun and build small business skills from selling crafts. Let us pray for Hummingbird Ministries as it walks with Aboriginal people on the journey towards social, spiritual and emotional recovery.
